The Department of Architecture seeks applications for an open-rank position in the **Theory of Architecture**. Following the principle that architecture is continually refunded by theoretical reflection that connects teaching and practice meaningfully to external discourses, the Department seeks a scholar actively engaged in contemporary debates in theory as well as in the critical understanding of architectural design. Candidates must demonstrate accomplishments in theory teaching and publication as well as ongoing theoretical speculation that can, potentially, redefine traditional theory fields.

The successful candidate will be able to promote the Department's commitments to criticality, studio education, and the necessity to connect architecture to developments in related fields. The successful candidate must have a Ph.D. or equivalent. The candidate will be active in the accredited B.Arch. program, serve on committees at the post-professional M.Arch. and Ph.D. level, and assist in planning advanced degree programs and courses.

Candidates are asked to furnish a letter of intent, a curriculum vitae, and the names, phone numbers, mail and e-mail addresses of three references able to provide a knowledgeable evaluation of the applicant's qualifications. Additional materials will be requested at a later stage.
